Resolution of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine
of 26.02.2026 № 373 “On approval of the Procedure for admission to study for
higher education in 2026”

Peculiarities of Admission of Foreigners and Stateless Persons to the European Medical University (Extract from The Admission Rules to EMU in 2026)

1. Admission of foreigners and stateless persons to the European Medical University (EMU) is based on Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine dated February 26, 2026, No. 373, registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on March 20, 2026, No. 374/45768 and conducted in accordance with the Laws of Ukraine "On Higher Education", "On the Legal Status of Foreigners and Stateless Persons", "On Foreign Ukrainians", "On Refugees and Persons in Need of Additional or Temporary Protection", "On Establishing Additional Legal and Social Guarantees for Citizens of the Republic of Poland Staying in Ukraine"; the Decree of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated September 12, 2018, No. 729 "On Higher Education for Certain Categories of Citizens"; The Order of Organizing Admission to Institutions of Professional, Specialized Pre-higher and Higher Education of Ukraine and Training (Internships) of Foreigners and Stateless Persons using the Unified Interdepartmental Information system of Ukraine for Foreigners and Stateless Persons willing to study at Institutions of Professional, Specialized Pre-higher and Higher Education of Ukraine approved by the Decree of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated June 28, 2024, No. 758; the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine dated November 1, 2013, No. 1541 "Certain Issues of Organizing Admission and Training (Internships) for Foreigners and Stateless Persons," registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on November 25, 2013, No. 2004/24536, the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine dated December 2, 2019, No. 1498 "On Approving the Procedure for Establishing Quotas for Foreigners and Stateless Persons to Obtain Higher Education Within the State Order According to Ukraine's International Agreements," registered with the Ministry of Justice of Ukraine on February 10, 2020, No. 153/34436. The citizens of the russian federation, the islamic republic of iran, the republic of bilarus and north korean people' democratic republic who do not have permanent residence permits in Ukraine are admitted to study upon the individual permission of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine.

2. Foreigners and stateless persons, stateless persons who have applied for refugee status, persons who have applied for protection in Ukraine and have submitted the certificate of applying for protection (hereinafter referred to as foreigners) are allowed to get higher education for the funds of physical and legal entities unless the other is presupposed by international agreements of Ukraine (the necessity of their fulfillment is to be agreed be Verhovna Rada), acting legislation and agreements between institutions of higher education concerning international academic mobility. Admission of foreigners for higher education is conducted for accredited educational programs (Appendix 1 to the present Rules). Foreigners may also be admitted for preparatory programs, including studies of the state language and/or the language of instruction.

3. Admission of foreigners can be conducted in person and/or remotely. Admission of foreigners is conducted with the use of Unified Interdepartmental Information System of Ukraine for foreigners and stateless persons willing to study at institutions of professional, specialized pre_higher and higher education of Ukraine (hereinafter referred to as Unified system) The validity period of the electronic invitation issued in Unified system is 6 months after putting qualified electronic seal of EMU or qualified electronic signature of the person authorized by EMU. The remote admission is allowed for Foreigners who have received an electronic invitation for study and have the education documents legalized in the country of their issuance: legalization at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA) of the country that issued the educational document and legalization at the consular section

of a Ukrainian diplomatic mission abroad (consular legalization or apostille). To organize remote admission of foreign citizens for higher education and preparatory programs, including studies of the state language and/or the language of instruction, EMU carries out the identification of the person and entrance exams in remote format with videorecording (including the recording from the screen of applicant's device). The recording is saved for 5 years in the university and the reference to the recording is uploaded to the USEDE. In case of remote admission foreigner sends to EMU by means of post services legalized and notarized copies of the documents of previous education. Upon the first crossing of the state border of Ukraine and arrival to the university foreigner submits the original documents in person. The list of Partner Organizations with which EMU has an Agreement for Remote Conduct of Entrance Examinations for Foreigners is available in Appendix 8 to the present Rules.

4. Terms for submitting applications and documents for foreign applicants: For obtaining a Master's degree in medical specialties – twice a year:

- From 09:00 on January 1, 2026, to 12:00 on March 30, 2026.
- From 09:00 on August 1, 2026, to 12:00 on October 30, 2026;

For studies in the preparatory programs – throughout the year.

5. Foreign applicants must submit the following documents to the admission committee (if admission is conducted in person): - An application of the established form, confirming with the applicant's personal signature that they have been informed of the Admission Rules, the valid license, and the accreditation certificate for the educational program (specialty) they are applying to. - A copy of the educational document and academic transcript with grades, with an average score of no less than 150 out of 200, provided that the applicant has studied and achieved at least 150 points in competitive subjects.

- The average grade of the previous educational qualification and the grades in competitive subjects are calculated by EMU in accordance with the Procedure for Calculating the Average Grade of the Secondary Education Document for Foreign Citizens and Stateless Persons. Educational documents must be authenticated in the country of issue in a manner officially recognized in that country and legalized by the relevant foreign diplomatic institution of Ukraine, unless otherwise provided by international treaties of Ukraine.

- Medical certificate of the applicant's health status, certified by the official healthcare authority of the country of origin, issued no later than two months before arrival in Ukraine for study. - Health insurance policy for emergency medical care (except for foreigners from countries that have agreements with Ukraine on free emergency medical services).

- A copy of the birth certificate (if necessary).

- Eight color photographs, size 30×40 mm All listed documents must be translated into Ukrainian and the translation must be notarized. Copies of documents are accepted only if the originals are presented.

6. Enrollment of foreign nationals into EMU's preparatory department is conducted without entrance examinations. The enrollment of foreign citizens into programs for obtaining a master's degree in medical fields is based on the applicant's previously obtained educational qualification,

the results of an entrance examination for foreigners in the specified subjects and language of instruction (Appendix 3), and the academic rights to continue education provided by the educational document issued in the applicant's country. The assessment also takes into account academic performance scores that qualify the applicant to continue education at the next level of higher education according to the legislation of the country where the qualification was obtained. Entrance examinations are held according to the schedule during the following periods:

- From 09:00 on January 2, 2026, to 12:00 on March 31, 2026;
- From 09:00 on August 2, 2026, to 12:00 on October 31, 2026.

7. Calculation of the Competitive Score The applicant's Competitive Score (CS) is calculated using the formula: $CS = C1 \times S1 + C2 \times S2$, where: S1, S2 — scores for the first and second competitive subjects (on a 100–200 scale), C1 = 0.4, C2 = 0.6 — subject coefficients for respective subjects. Graduates of the Preparatory Department for International Citizens at EMU are admitted to the first year based on final examinations, provided they score no less than 150 points in each competitive subject and the language of instruction.

8. Admission Periods for Self-Funded International Students Admission of international students on the basis of funding by individuals and/or legal entities is carried out:

- From January 2, 2026 to March 31, 2026;
- From August 2, 2026 to October 31, 2026 – for master's degree programs.

Throughout the year – for preparatory programs.

9. Enrollment Orders and Study Confirmation All categories of international applicants are enrolled at EMU on the basis of official enrollment orders. The fact of enrollment can be confirmed by a certificate generated in USEDE (Unified State Electronic Database on Education).

10. The requirements of EMU to international applicants' eligibility to the Order and Rules of Admission, as well as deadlines for submitting applications and documents, entrance exams, and enrollment procedures, are outlined in the Admission Rules and published on the official website of EMU.

11. Academic Mobility and Joint Programs International students arriving in Ukraine to participate in academic mobility programs or to pursue higher education under joint educational programs agreed upon between EMU and a foreign higher education institution are admitted based on the contractual obligations of the respective institutions.

12. Rights of Foreigners and Stateless Persons Foreigners and stateless persons, including foreign Ukrainians who permanently reside in Ukraine, refugees, and persons in need of additional protection, have the right to receive higher education on equal terms with citizens of Ukraine, including at the expense of the state or local budget, except in cases specified by the Constitution of Ukraine, Ukrainian laws, or international treaties ratified by the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine. Foreign Ukrainians whose status is confirmed by a Certificate of a Foreign Ukrainian (excluding those who permanently reside in Ukraine) may be admitted to state-funded study within the established quota for foreigners, based on the results of entrance examinations for foreigners in subjects specified by the Admission Rules
